#### Michigan Christian Convention Historical information 1956 - 2021

Not a lot of information is known regarding the beginning of the Michigan Christian Convention. We do know that in 1955, there was an active central Michigan Minister's meeting and it is probable that O.A. Trinkle introduced the idea of a convention for the state of Michigan at one of their meetings. This got the ball rolling, and an advisory committee was established. Their first meeting was in Lansing on January 23, 1956. Posters were printed and mailed out in March.

- The first planning for the Michigan Convention began in 1956
  - (CS,2/18) Michigan Convention planned when 35 preachers and 3 elders met in Lansing on January 9 to complete plans for a Michigan Convention of Churches of Christ.
